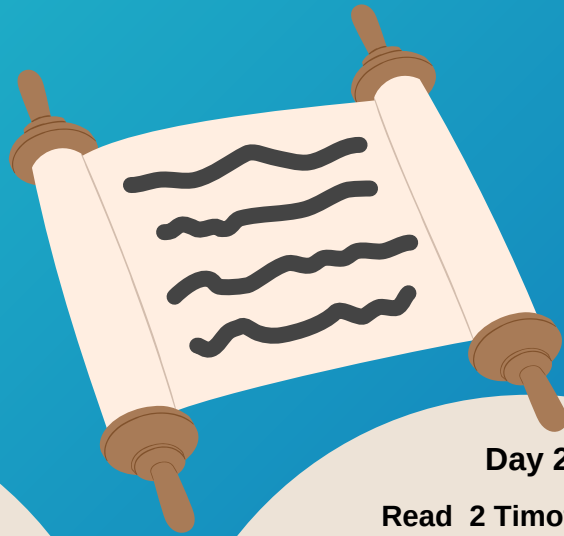


# BIBLE BASICS

Learning foundational truths about God's word.

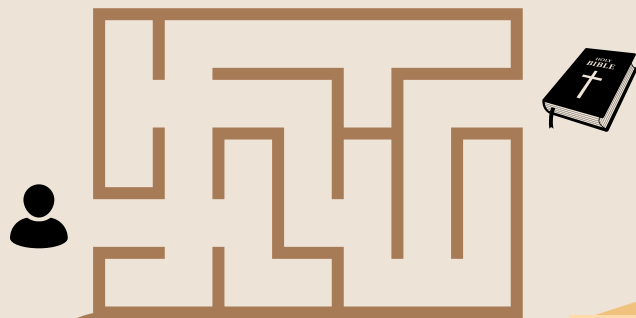


## Day 1

### FIND AND KEEP GOD'S WORD HIDDEN IN YOUR HEART



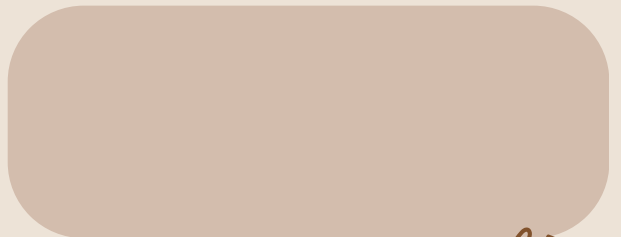
## Day 2

### Read 2 Timothy 3:16

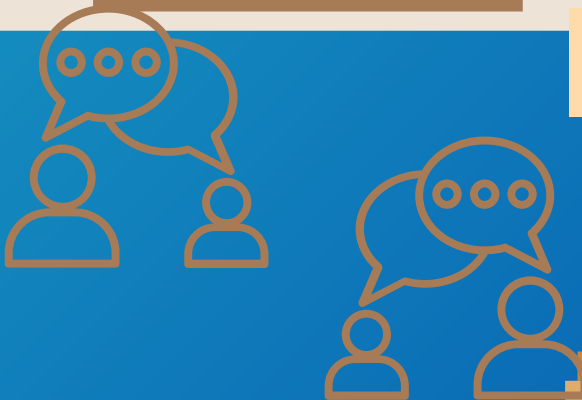
