

Bottom Line: Live at peace with your family.



Host: "Hey kids! Welcome back to "Northview Kids: At the movies"! All month long, we're watching clips from some great movies and learning about God's design for families. Every family is unique. No two families are exactly alike, and this family is no exception. We all experience un-peacefulness sometimes... Do you ever argue with your siblings or parents? In the movie, Lilo lives with her older sister, Nani. Nani is trying very hard to take care of Lilo, but Lilo does not always listen and this causes them to argue. But God calls us to live at peace with our family members. Romans 12:18 says, "If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone." I'm so glad to see Lilo and Nani found a way to make peace with one another after their argument, but the peace won't last long! In the last scene, we saw Stitch (also known as Experiment 626), an alien from outer space, crash onto the island where Lilo and Nani live. He is very wild and likes to cause trouble. Lilo finds Stitch and thinks he is a dog and adopts him. Two other aliens, Jumba and Pleakley (show picture of them on screen), have been sent to capture Stitch and take him home to outer space. This is really going to stir things up for Lilo and Nani and cause them not to live at peace with one another and their new family member, Stitch. Let's watch as the craziness unfolds. Host: Wow! There are a lot of crazy things happening to Lilo and her family! Are there times that chaos in your family makes it difficult to live at peace with the other people in your home? Maybe you are arguing with your brother or sister over who gets to pick the TV show or you are frustrated with your mom or dad for making you clean up your toys before you play outside and you respond by yelling and stomping your feet. But as we learned earlier in Romans 12:18, even when things are chaotic, God wants us to find peace. As the movie continues, things begin to get even crazier for Lilo and her family as another alien, Captain Gantu (show picture on screen), comes to Earth to try and capture Stitch and take him back home. The crazier it gets, the more difficult it becomes for Lilo, Nani and Stitch to live at peace. Let's tune back in to see what happens next! (50 seconds)



Host: Things finally seem to be turning around for Lilo, Nani and Stitch when Nani finally finds a job! But then Jumba comes to capture Stitch and things become so UNpeaceful in Lilo's family that she decides to run away! There are times when situations in our family may seem so crazy and unpeaceful that it makes us want to run or isolate ourselves from our family or even God. But did you know if you turn TOWARD God during these difficult times in your life he can help you get through them? John 14:27 says, "I leave you peace. My peace I give you. I do not give it to you as the world does. So don't let your hearts be troubled. Don't be afraid" (ICB). If we turn to God when there are times of trouble and UNpeacefulness in our family he will help us through it and restore the peace. After Lilo runs away, she finds out Stitch is an alien too and he can talk! As they are talking, they are captured by Captain Gantu and taken to his spaceship. Stitch manages to escape, but as he is trying to save Lilo, he falls off the spaceship as it is taking off! A few minutes later, Stitch, Nani, Jumba and Pleakley run into one another and they all decide to make peace and work together to save Lilo.
